


This week's theme is LOVE. This is week 4 of your advent count down, Christmas day is almost here! This week make sure you look ahead at the 'challenge together'

READ TOGETHER

If you have a bible, why not turn to Matthew 2: 1-21 and read it out loud? In this part of the story, Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem because they need to register for the census. While they were there, the time for Mary to give birth arrived but so many people were in Bethlehem every place to stay was full. They ended up in a stable and it was here that Mary gave birth to a son. He was wrapped in cloths and his bed was just a manger (which is an animal feeding trough!). They named him Jesus, as the angels had said, and he was the son of God. The shepherds came all the way to Bethlehem to meet him and later the Magi (wise men) travel to find him too. Everyone who saw him was amazed and went away praising God and giving him thanks.


